Bishop McManus will launch this initiative in the Diocese of Down at the 10.00am mass in the Cathedral of St. Patrick & Columba, Newry, on Sunday 13th April 2008, Good Shepherd Sunday. The Year of Vocation aims to lead all towards fulfilling their role of Witness, Love and Service in the church. For that our diocese, our parish and all parishes will support and encourage those to whom God is calling, "Come, Follow me!" (Gospel of St. Matthew) While the Year of Vocation begins on Good Shepherd Sunday this year and will end on Good Shepherd Sunday in 2009, the task of developing 'a culture of vocations' in the diocese is a long-term project that will demand consistent prayer and effort.
