It is very frustrating to realise that what started out as a small website for our own little patch, has reached all corners of the globe and united everyone with Tullylish in their hearts. The JUNIOR SCHEME will be based primarily in the Laurencetown Community Centre and will run for 1 week from Monday 20th July to Friday 24th July from 10am to 1pm each day for children who are in Primary 4 to Primary 7 inclusive. Activities include sports, art, craft, pottery, drama, hip-hop, competitions and trips. A tuck shop with a healthy eating option is available. Children who are in Primary 6 and Primary 7 may join the Senior Scheme if they wish. Cost for the week is £2 with an additional fee for trips.

The MINI SCHEME will be based in the Laurencetown Community Centre and will run for one week from Monday 2nd July until Friday 31st July, 10am to 1pm each day for children who are in Primary 1 to Primary 3 inclusive. Activities will include sports, art, craft, music and trips. A healthy eating break is provided. Cost for the week is £2. There will be an additional fee for trips.

The SENIOR SCHEME will be based in the Tullylish Gaelic Club and will run for 2 weeks from Monday 3rd August to Friday 14th August, 10am to 1pm each day for young people who are 11 years +. A tuck shop with a healthy eating option is available. Activities will include sports, art, craft, music and trips. A healthy eating break is provided. Cost for the week is £2. There will be an additional fee for trips.
