 As you know, Sr. Bernadette is home on holidays and, unfortunately, time has flown and it's almost time for
 her return to South Africa.

By now, we all know her very difficult battle to influence patterns of behaviour in South Africa to prevent
 the spread of AIDS. We hear the reports on television, watch the various RELIEF programmes, and, for a
 fleeting moment, express our sympathy or maybe even donate a few and then go on about our business be-
 cause, after all, it has nothing to do with us.

Of course we can't all go to Africa, or any Third world country, but we know someone personally, one of our
 own, who has given her life to help these people, to help stop the spread of AIDS. Surely, the least we can do
 is support her work financially - take the burden of fund-raising from her shoulders.

At the moment, we have over 20 parishes who pledge money through standing orders, either annually and yearly. Pledges range
 from £2.50 to £50 per month and over the past three years, we have raised £15,000 in this way. Aided by donations and fund raising,
 the total amount raised to date through Education Aid is over £25,000.
