Please note again that everyone for their ongoing contribution as every young helps to run a national course of this magnitude. From the bottom of my heart, I thank each of you for your kindness, support and financial assistance.

The report has been put on the website and a well worth reading. A covering note explains the progress. We are now at the end of another pleasurable year and from our annual pleasurable, these celebrations are now due. Fr. B. and Fr.
