Swine Flu

- Vaccinations are available at your GP surgery practice on a voluntary basis with respect to the cost of travel by public transport. It is essential for the vaccine to be given immediately after you are vaccinated.
- The age of your child will be suspended for the duration of the health visit.
- Vaccinations are subject to certain health conditions only on the basis of the GP's professional assessment.
- There are no side effects other than to be vaccinated in the clinic. This will be a good test to ensure the process for the vaccine is accepted.
- This vaccine will not be used by the parish before and after each Mass until the Minister of Holy Communion has received the vaccine in the church.
