The T.L.C. Group and "Women from the Heart"
The "Women from the Heart" Project is an Australian project - a tribute to women, especially the 25,000+ convict women who were shipped to "prize unknown" and became the backbone of contemporary Australian society.
The woman behind the project is Australian artist, Christina Henri and she wanted 55,000 convict women made with empathy for these convict women who endured so much and yet have received so little recognition. Their economic and social contribution was enormous, yet the "stigma" surrounding their existence always precluded discussion of their value. To date she has 15,000 tonnes.
A lot of these women were from the four corners of Ireland and for most, their only crime was stealing food for their families. Christmas invites people throughout the world to make a honest tribute to commemorate the value of a convict woman's life. The artist deliberately chose to invite personal tributes to be made rather than mass orders so that each woman is a testament to the individuality of the lass for whom it is created. She is holding a "Flowering of the Tombes" in Gifford on September 11/12.
We now have a "ship of Irish convict women" to choose from and each woman will bear the name of one of these women, the name of the person/group who made the basket and a little rose.
